Measures 47-51. The Piano part (Pno.) has a right hand with dense chordal textures and a left hand with a melodic line. The Organ part (Org.) has a right hand with sustained chords and a left hand with a melodic line. A 'D.S. al Coda' instruction is present at the end of the system. A '3' indicates a triplet in the Piano left hand at measure 51.
